




About the project

- This project will enable the development of a model for embedding digital resources into teachers' pedagogical practice. This model consists of two dimensions:
- one dealing with the types of factors associated with teacher take-up of digital content;
- and the other one, concerned with the characteristics of various stakeholders and the nature of digital curriculum resources (the content) and supporting technology (the tools).
- Dedicated toolkit will be provided that offers (aspiring) teachers the means to create digital learning content and to deploy digital inclusive education practices almost instantly.






Target groups and beneficiaries

 - their parents






IO1: New didactic model for embedding digital curriculum resources into inclusive teachers' pedagogical practice

- There will be 15 chapters included in this IO






IO2: Handbook "Steps for transferring a course online in an inclusive manner"

- Steps for transferring a course online in an inclusive manner






IO3: Set of instructive graphs (online, mobile and printable) and explanatory animated videos to support the implementation of inclusive remote education

Some of the activities in this IO are:


- Creation of set of instructive graphs






One of our practices included in the e-learning portal: Picture Dictation








A scale/ladder of success
